> Global Marketing & Expanded Footprint:

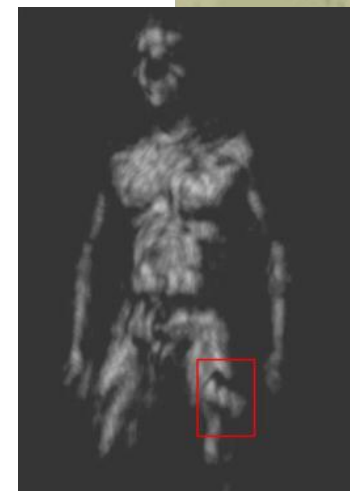
